### 2018 SUMMER SHOW AND SALE

JULY 7<sup>TH</sup> THROUGH AUGUST 25<sup>TH</sup>, 2018

#### Critical Dates:

Entry deadline is midnight on Monday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> (no late entries will be accepted). Enter online at [www.richardson-arts.org](http://www.richardson-arts.org).

Take-in on Saturday, July 7<sup>th</sup>, 10:30 a.m. to 12:30p.m.

Pick-up on Saturday, August 25<sup>th</sup> 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

The RCAS Summer Show and Sale is a non-juried show. Photographs of your work are not required. There is no entry fee and no awards will be given. There is no restriction on the age of the artwork, so you can enter older artwork that you still have on hand. It is a great opportunity for RCAS members to show and sell their work. You must be a paid-up member of RCAS to participate. The RCAS fiscal year runs from June 1<sup>st</sup> through May 31<sup>st</sup>, so dues for the 2018-2019 fiscal year are due after May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018. If you have not yet paid your dues for the 2018-2019 year, you may do so online at <http://richardson-arts.org/JoinRCAS.html>, or you may download and print the form at <http://richardson-arts.org/PDF/MemberShipApplication.pdf> and mail your payment to the address shown on the form.

You may enter up to five (5) paintings for this show. The paintings must be framed and wired for hanging with D-Rings (no eye-screws or saw-tooth hangers) (gallery-wrapped paintings will be accepted, but the sides of the canvas must be painted with no staples showing). They must adhere to the Library's requirements (no nudes, religious or controversial political subject matter), no glass except for pastels and charcoal. The minimum image size must be 100 sq. in. (example 10X10 or any size where multiplying the height x width equals 100 sq. in. or more). The maximum framed size is 42 inches on any side. We encourage (but do not require) artists to exhibit pieces with moderate "sale" prices as this show is a good opportunity to clear out your older inventory, and pieces priced under \$100 seem to sell the best at this show. You may, of course, enter paintings up to the maximum size allowed and price them as you wish. There is a 20% commission to be paid to RCAS on all sales. RCAS and/or the Richardson Library will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any work. All paintings must remain displayed for the duration of the show. Entry into the show indicates your agreement to these terms.

Take-in will be on Saturday, July 7<sup>th</sup> from 10:30a.m. to 12:30p.m. on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Richardson Library at 900 Civic Center Dr., Richardson, TX 75080. Pick-up will be on Saturday, August 25<sup>th</sup> from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Richardson Library. Paintings must be delivered to the library on the specified take-in date. No late entries will be accepted.

You must enter online at [www.richardson-arts.org](http://www.richardson-arts.org) no later than midnight on Monday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>. There is no entry fee and you do not have to submit photos of your artwork.
